# VILLA ESPERANZA SERVICES ADULT PROGRAMS

#### **Adult Day Program**

- Assists those with intellectual/developmental and physical challenges, including age-related frailty
- Maintains an individual's independence and decreases social isolation
- Provides day respite for caregivers

#### **Dimensions Adult Day Program**

- For young adults/those retired from a work program
- Develops an individual's functional, cognitive, and behavioral skills required for community integration
- Offers pre-employment training through volunteer work in the community

# Community Integration Program (CIP)

- Community-based, pre-employment skills training through volunteerism
- Mobility training & Skill building activities

## **Employment Services**

- Inclusive, community-based employment and work placement program
- Provides job coaching and assists with job skills such as resume writing, interview practice, goal setting, and more
- Matches individual's career goals with community employers



# Adult Independent Living Skills & Supported Living Services (ILS/SLS)

- Supports individuals seeking to maintain a selfsustaining, independent life in the community
- Areas of support include money management, cooking, social skills, community resources, health and safety and more

- Seven independent living homes in Pasadena
